2. Qualifications and requirements

The applicants must meet these following criteria.

2.1 The candidates must hold a M.6 (Grade12) certificate or its equivalent issued by the Ministry of Education, or equivalent certificates from local or overseas educational institutions recognized by the Ministry of Education, Thailand.

2.2 The candidates must be a Thai citizen.

2.3 Grade Point Average (CGPA) Criteria

2.3.1 The recipients with waiver of full tuition fees must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above.

2.3.2 The recipients with waiver of 50% tuition fees must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or above.

2.4 For those candidates who are disqualified according to 2.3, must show evidence of outstanding performance in activities and/or sports for committees' consideration.

- 2.5 The candidates must have no serious criminal record or record of bad behavior.
- 2.6 The candidates should have pleasant personality.
- 2.7 The candidates should be physically and mentally fit.
- 2.8 The candidates must have no record of serious communicable diseases.
- 2.9 The candidates must have no record of drug abuse.
- 2.10 The candidates must have English Proficiency Test Result appointed by the college.

3. Application Process

- 3.1 The candidates request and submit the Application form at Admission Department, or visit www.dtc.ac.th
- 3.2 The candidates can submit the Application form during the office hours (Mon – Fri, 08.30 am – 5.30 pm).

4. Required Documents

- 4.1 One complete application form with 3 photographs of 1 inch x 1 inch
- 4.2 A copy of student's Thai national ID card
- 4.3 A copy of student's house registration
- 4.4 Two copies of high school transcript/high school certificate
- 4.5 Letter of certification for no record of bad behavior
- 4.6 English Proficiency Test Result
- 4.7 A Portfolio containing academic and professional achievements plus PDF file

6. Scholarship Selection Process

- 6.1 All completed applications accompanied by all required supporting materials as well as a personal and interview will be reviewed by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee to ensure that every applicant receives full consideration.
- 6.2 Candidates will be scored using a points system based on the quality of the content provided and scholarships will be awarded in a manner that matches the higher monetary award amounts with the better qualified candidates who meet all the requisite criteria.
- 6.3 All decisions by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee are final and any attempts by candidates to lobby or persuade the committee during the process will result in immediate disqualification.
