1. Scholarship Details (Bangkok Campus)

1.1 Waiver of 50% tuition fees

1.1.1 B.B.A Program in Hospitality Management (International Program)

1.2 Waiver of 25% tuition fees

1.2.1 B.B.A Program in Professional Culinary Arts (International Program)

2. Qualifications and requirements

The applicants must meet these following criteria.

- 2.1 The candidates must own a citizenship of ASEAN or Asia-Pacific countries (except Thailand).
- 2.2 The candidates must hold a high school certificate or its equivalent from local or overseas educational institutions recognized by the Ministry of Education, Thailand.
- 2.3 The Grade Point Average (CGPA) Criteria
 - 2.3.1. The recipients with waiver of 25% and 50% tuition fees must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or above.
- 2.4 The candidates must have no serious criminal record or record of bad behavior.
- 2.5 The candidates should have pleasant personality.
- 2.6 The candidates must have no record of serious communicable diseases.
- 2.7 The candidates must have no record of drug abuse.
- 2.8 The candidates must have English Proficiency Test Result appointed by the college or have a minimum TOEFL-PBT or TOEFL-ITP ≥ 500 or TOEFL-IBT ≥ 61 or IELTS ≥ 5.5 or SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing ≥ 500 and SAT Math ≥ 500 . All scores must be for examinations taken within two years of the application date.

3. Application Process

3.1 The candidates request and submit the Application form at Admission Department, or visit www.dtc.ac.th

3.2 The candidates can submit the Application form during the office hours (Mon – Fri, 08.30 – 17.30 hrs.).

4. Required Documents

4.1 One complete application form with 3 photographs of 1 inch x 1 inch

4.2 A copy of student's passport

4.3 Two copies of high school transcript/high school certificate which recognized by the Ministry of Education, Thailand

4.4 A certificate of conduct

4.5 A Portfolio containing academic and professional achievements

Note All copies must be endorsed by student's signature to certify true copies.

1st Semester Year 2023 – Special Round (*For schools that have signed the Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) with Dusit Thani College only.*)

1st Semester Year 2023 – Round I (Normal round)

Application Submission Now – September 30, 2022

Interview Day October 21 – 22, 2022

Announcement of Scholarship October 31, 2022

1st Semester Year 2023 – Round II (Normal round)

Application Submission Now – December 16, 2022

Interview Day January 07, 2023

Announcement of Scholarship January 16, 2023

6. Scholarship Selection Process

- 6.1 All completed applications accompanied by all required supporting materials as well as a personal and interview will be reviewed by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee to ensure that every applicant receives full consideration.
- 6.2 Candidates will be scored using a points system based on the quality of the content provided and scholarships will be awarded in a manner that matches the higher monetary award amounts with the better qualified candidates who meet all the requisite criteria.
- 6.3 All decisions by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee are final and any attempts by candidates to lobby or persuade the committee during the process will result in immediate disqualification.
