1.1.2 Waiver of 50% tuition fees

2. Eligibility and Scholarship Conditions

The applicants must meet these following criteria.

- 2.1 The applicants must own a citizenship of ASEAN or Asia-Pacific countries. (China, India, Indonesia, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Russia, Japan, the Philippines, Vietnam, Myanmar, South Korea, Malaysia, Nepal, Australia, Taiwan, Sri Lanka, Cambodia, Papua New Guinea, Laos, Singapore, New Zealand, Mongolia, Timor-Leste, Fiji, Bhutan, Solomon Islands, Maldives, Brunei Darussalam, Vanuatu, France, Samoa, the United States of America, Kiribati, Micronesia, Tonga, the Marshall Islands, Palau, Tuvalu, and Nauru)
- 2.2 The applicants must hold a high school certificate or its equivalent from local or overseas educational institutions recognized by the Ministry of Education, Thailand.
- 2.3 The Grade Point Average (CGPA) Criteria
 - 2.3.1 The recipients with a waiver of full tuition fees must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or above or GED total score of 650 or above. (4 subjects)
 - 2.3.2 The recipients with a waiver of 50% tuition fees must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above or GED total score of 613 or above. (4 subjects)
- 2.4 The applicants must have no serious criminal record or record of bad behavior.
- 2.5 The applicants should have pleasant personalities.
- 2.6 The applicants must have no record of serious communicable diseases.
- 2.7 The applicants must have no record of drug abuse.

2.8 The applicants must have English Proficiency Test Result appointed by the college.

3. Application Process

3.1 The candidates request and submit the application form at Admission Department, or visit www.dtc.ac.th

3.2 The candidates can submit the application form during the office hours (Mon – Fri, 08.30 – 17.30 hrs.).

4. Required Documents

4.1 One complete scholarship application form with 1 photograph of 1 inch x 1 inch.

4.2 A copy of student's passport.

4.3 Two copies of high school transcript/high school certificate which recognized by the Ministry of Education, Thailand.

4.4 A certificate of conduct (if any).

4.5 A Portfolio containing academic and professional achievements plus PDF file.

Note All copies must be endorsed by student's signature to certify true copies.

5.1 **First Semester Year 2027 – Special Round** (*Students from schools that have signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Dusit Thani College only.*)

Application Submission Now – December 12, 2026

Interview Day January 9, 2027

Announcement of Scholarship January 15, 2027

6. Scholarship Selection Process

6.1 All completed applications accompanied by all required supporting materials as well as a personal and interview will be reviewed by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee to ensure that every applicant receives full consideration.

- 6.2 Applicants will be scored using a points system based on the quality of the content provided and scholarships will be awarded in a manner that matches the higher monetary award amounts with the better qualified applicants who meet all the requisite criteria.
- 6.3 All decisions by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee are final and any attempts by applicants to lobby or persuade the committee during the process will result in immediate disqualification.
