

Mahogany Scholarship For Academic Year 2023 (For DTC current students)

"Mahogany Scholarship" shall be awarded to Dusit Thani College bachelor's degree students with excellence academic and behavioral performance. The details of the scholarship and candidate eligibility are as per below:

1. Candidate Eligibility

The applicants must meet the following criteria.

- 1.1 The applicants must be 2nd to 4th year students of Dusit Thani College.
- 1.2 The applicants must be the highest GPA student in the program with the minimum GPA of 3.5
- 1.3 The applicants must enroll for the subjects following the plan in handbook.
- 1.4 The total of credit must meet the criteria.
- 1.5 The applicants must have no credits transferred from Dusit Thani College or other higher education institutions.
- 1.6 The applicants must have no serious criminal record or record of bad behavior.
- 1.7 The applicants must have no record of drug abuse.

2. Scholarship Condition

- 2.1 The recipient will be awarded the 5,000 baht deduction of tuition fee for the next semester from the date of scholarship approval.
- 2.2 The recipient must be a student of Dusit Thani College on the effective date of scholarship, not withdrawal or being suspended.
- 2.3 Students who have received the Mahogany Scholarship are not eligible for any further College scholarships, except a reward.

3. Application Process

- 3.1 The applicants request and submit the application form at Student Service Department (Building 2, 2nd floor), or visit <u>www.dtc.ac.th</u>
- 3.2 The applicants can submit the application form during the office hours (Mon Fri, 08.30 17.30 hrs.).

4. Required Documents

- 4.1 One complete application form.
- 4.2 Two copies of transcript/high school certificate.
- 4.3 A certificate of conduct issued by the advisor.

5. Criteria Consideration

- 5.1 Student Affairs Division will list students with the highest academic results of each program when the results of each academic year are announced.
- 5.2 The Student Affairs Division will notify the students with highest scores of each program to apply for scholarships. The applicants have to apply and submit all required documents as specified in the announcement in person.
- 5.3 Applicants will be considered using academic results and scholarships will be awarded to applicants who meet all the requisite criteria. In case of same academic results, the total of enrolled credits and the family income will be used to consider.
- 5.4 All decisions by the Scholarship Application Evaluation Committee are final and any attempts by applicants to lobby or persuade the committee during the process will result in immediate disqualification.
